Asks doctors to adopt concept of 'Medical Social Responsibility'

New Delhi: The Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkiah Naidu has urged doctors belonging to the Indian diaspora to give back to the society by adopting their native villages and strengthening Primary Health Centres (PHCs). Inaugurating the 13th Global Healthcare Summit organized by the American Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (AAPI) and Global Association of Physicians of Indian Origin (GAPIO), in Hyderabad today, Shri Naidu called for bridging the gap by opening more medical colleges and increasing the number of seats at both graduate and post-graduate levels.

Referring to the report of McKinsey Global Institute which has estimated that the implementation of telemedicine technology could save \$4-5 billion every year and replace the need for in-person outpatient consultations in India, he wanted organizations like AAPI and GAPIO to help remote hospitals in India to acquire latest telemedicine equipment.

The Vice President said that it was also a need to organize massive awareness drives to a wellness based approach, a goal that has been clearly enunciated in the National Health Policy, 2017.
